

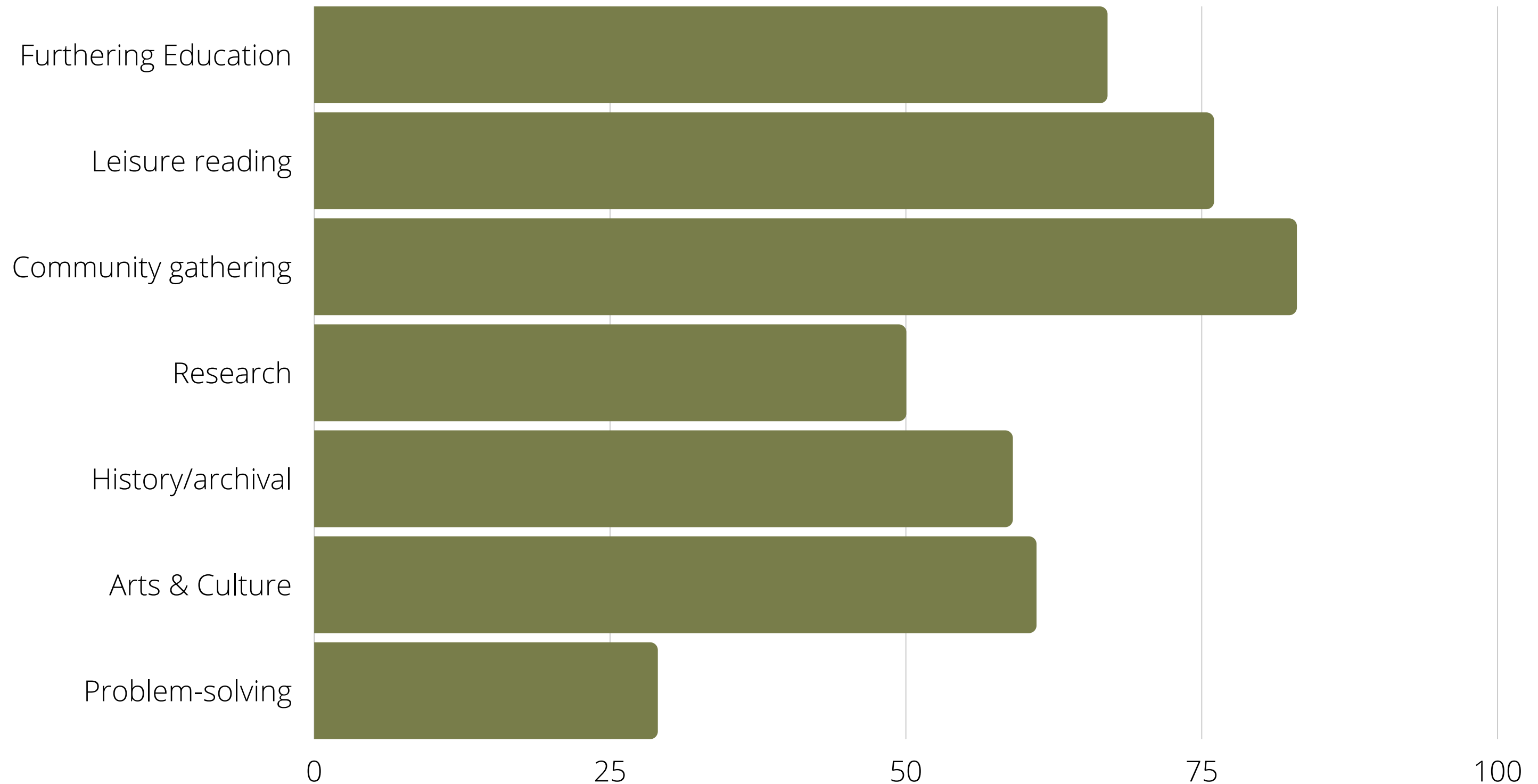

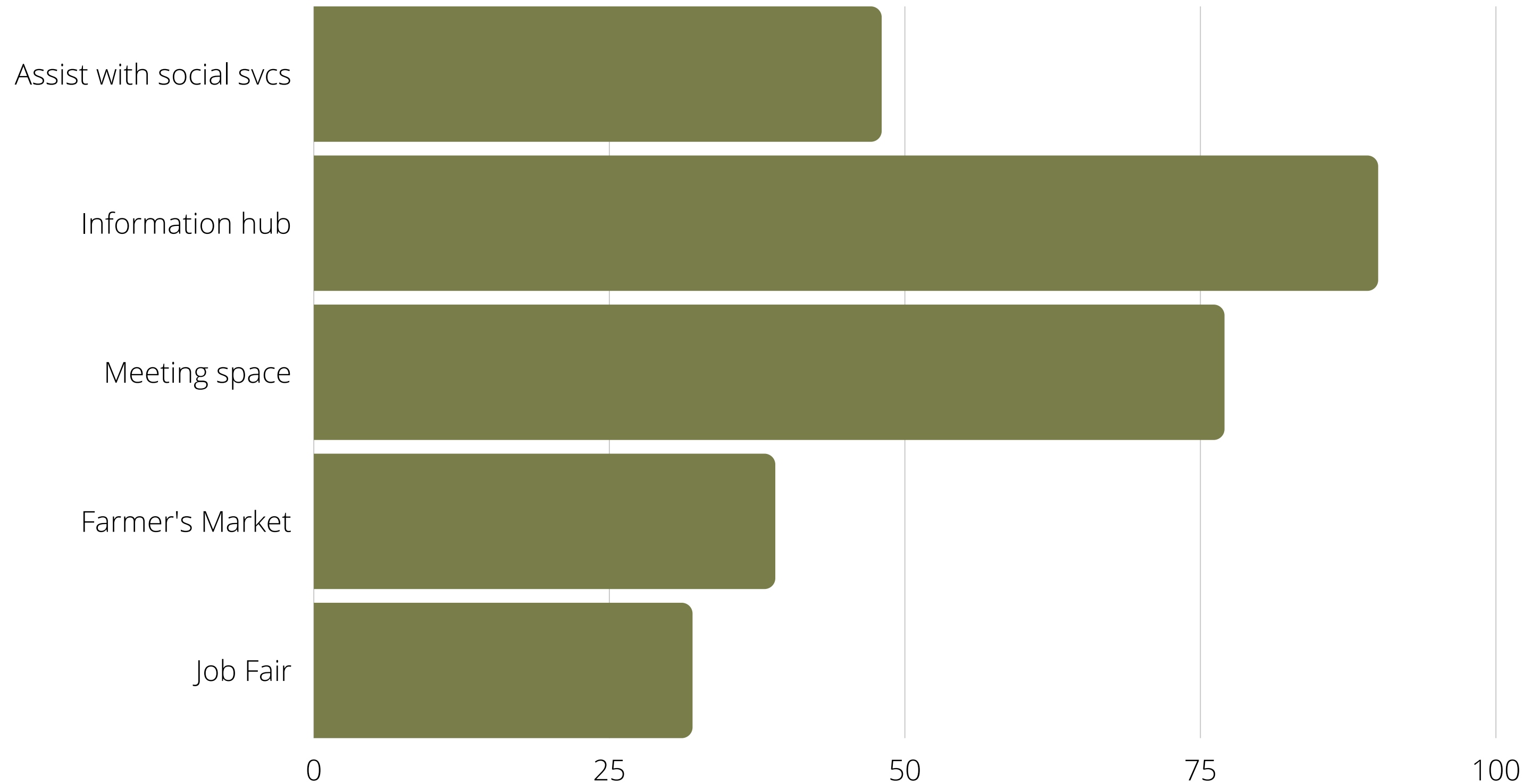

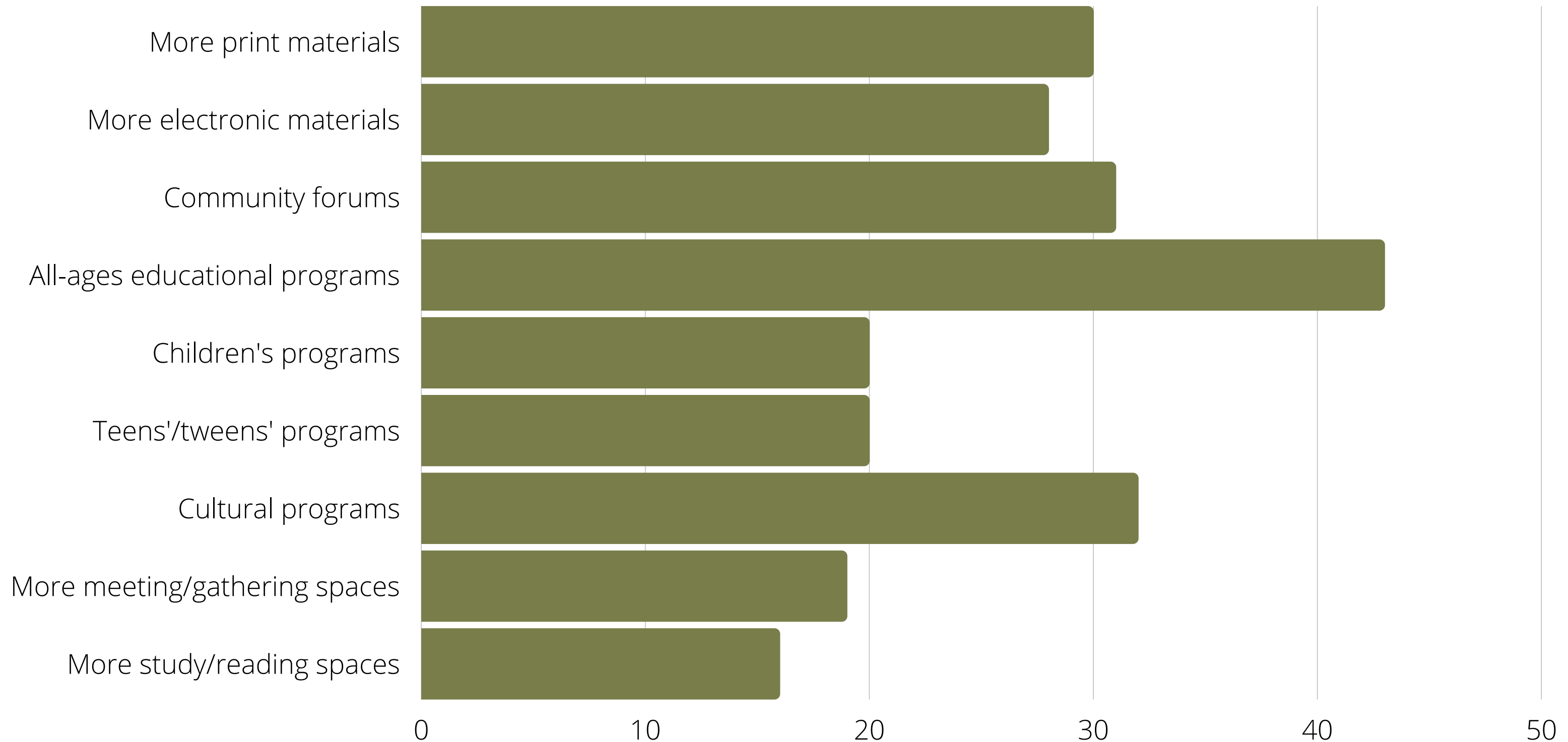
# 1. What do you consider the Library's primary functions to be?



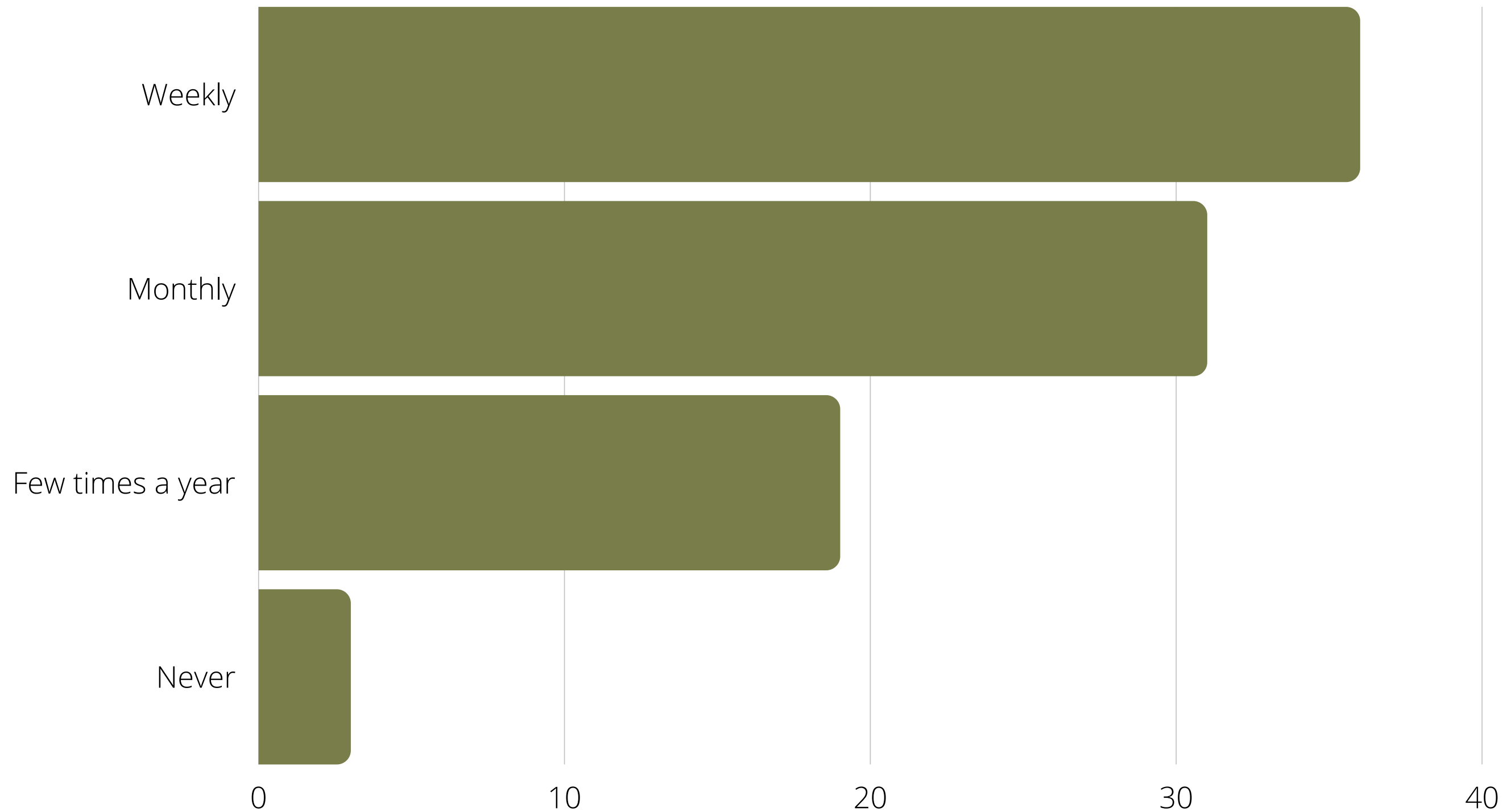

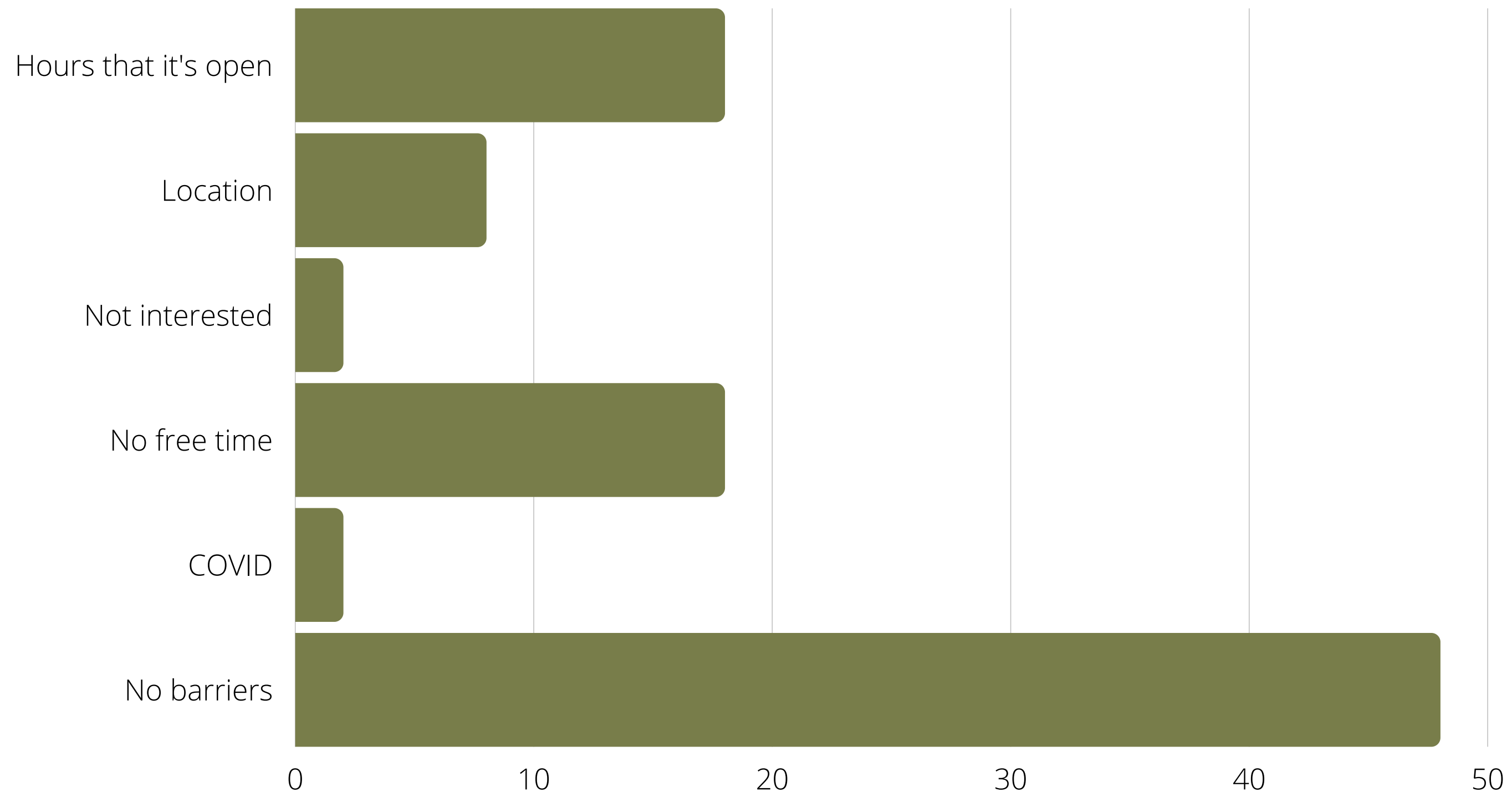
# 3. What would you like the Library to focus on?



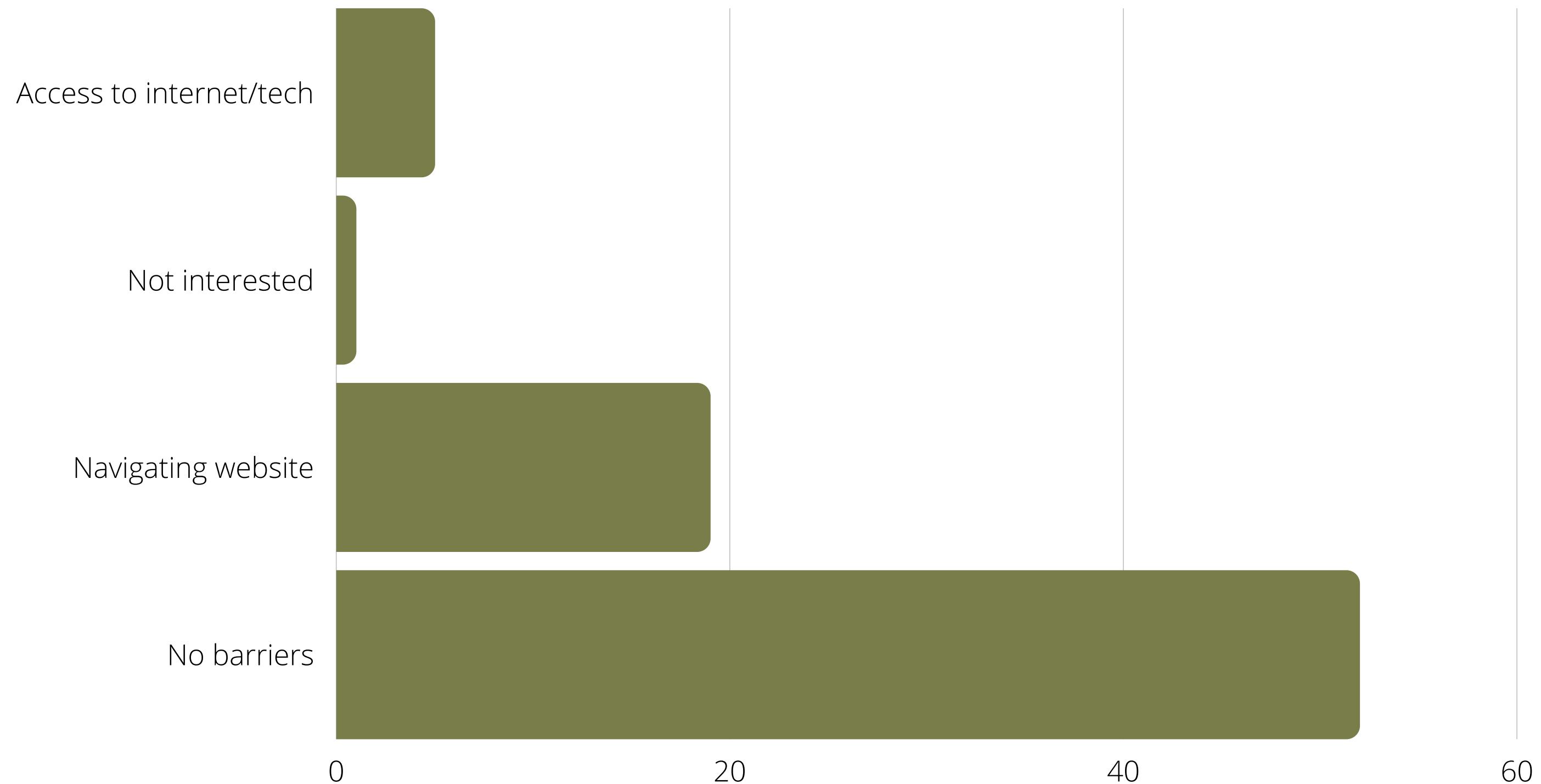
# 4. How often do you visit the Library or use online library services?



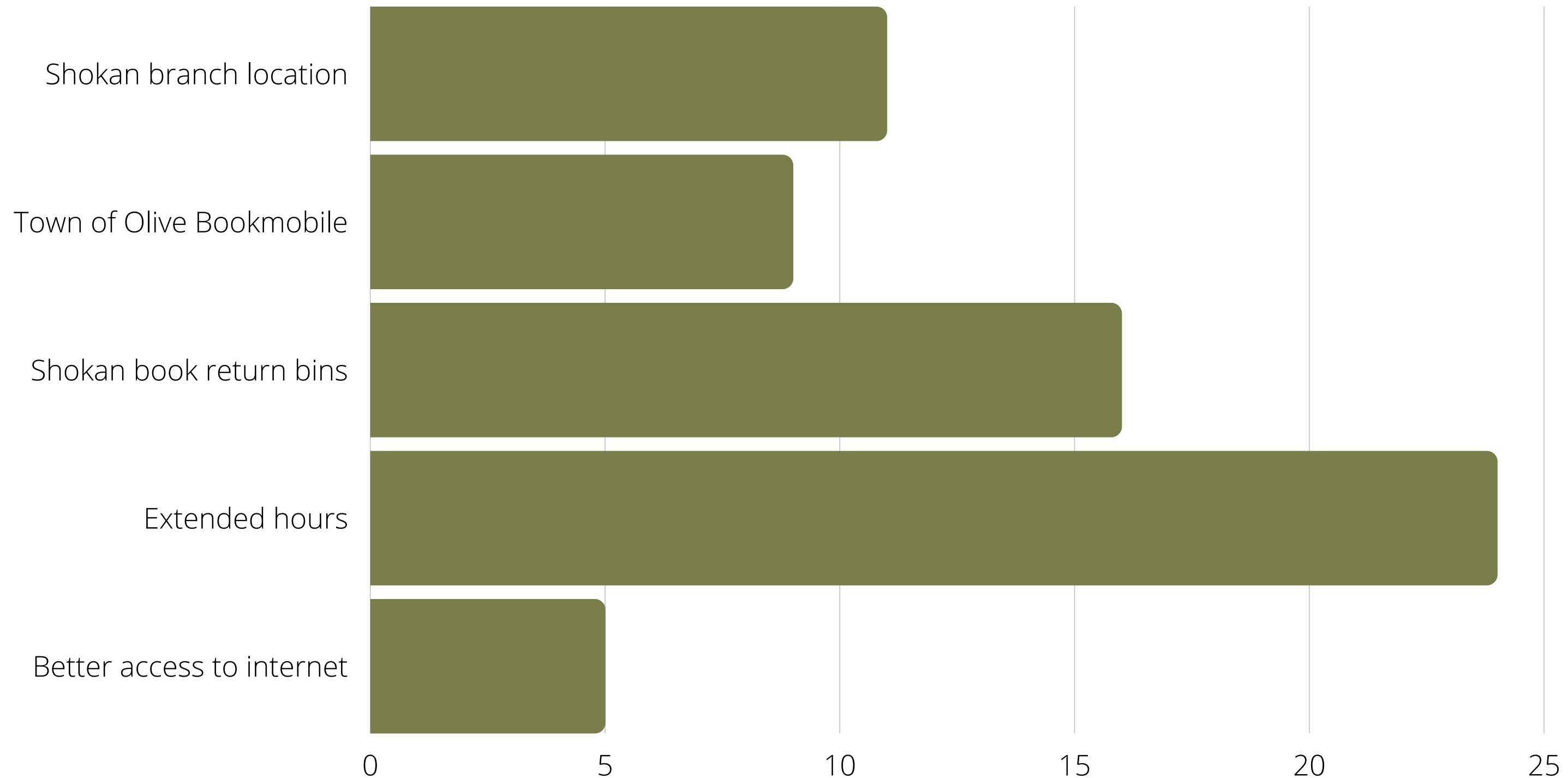
# 5. What is the most significant barrier to visiting the Library?



# 6. What is the most significant barrier to using online library services?

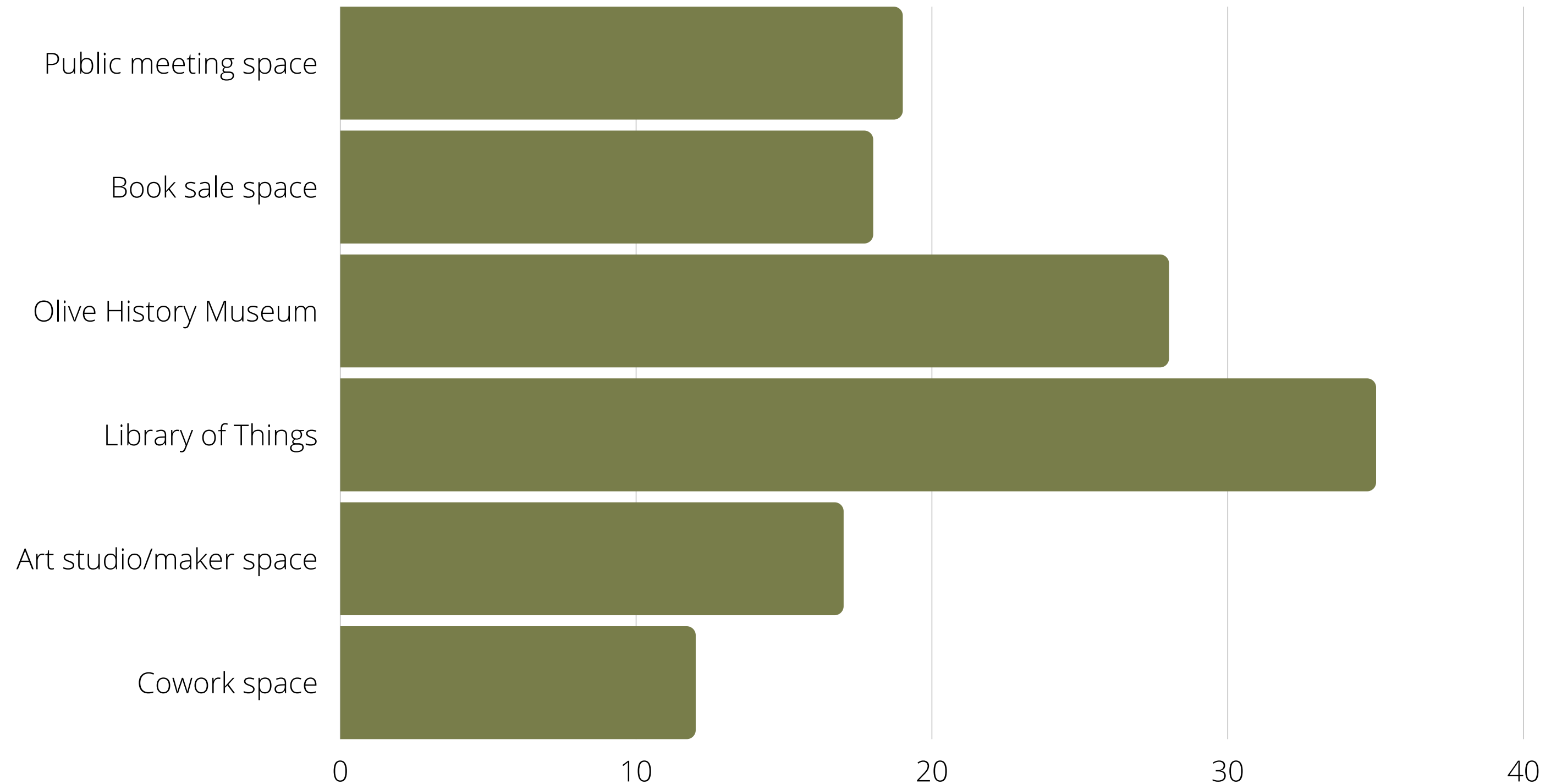


# 7. What would help break down barriers to in-person and online access?

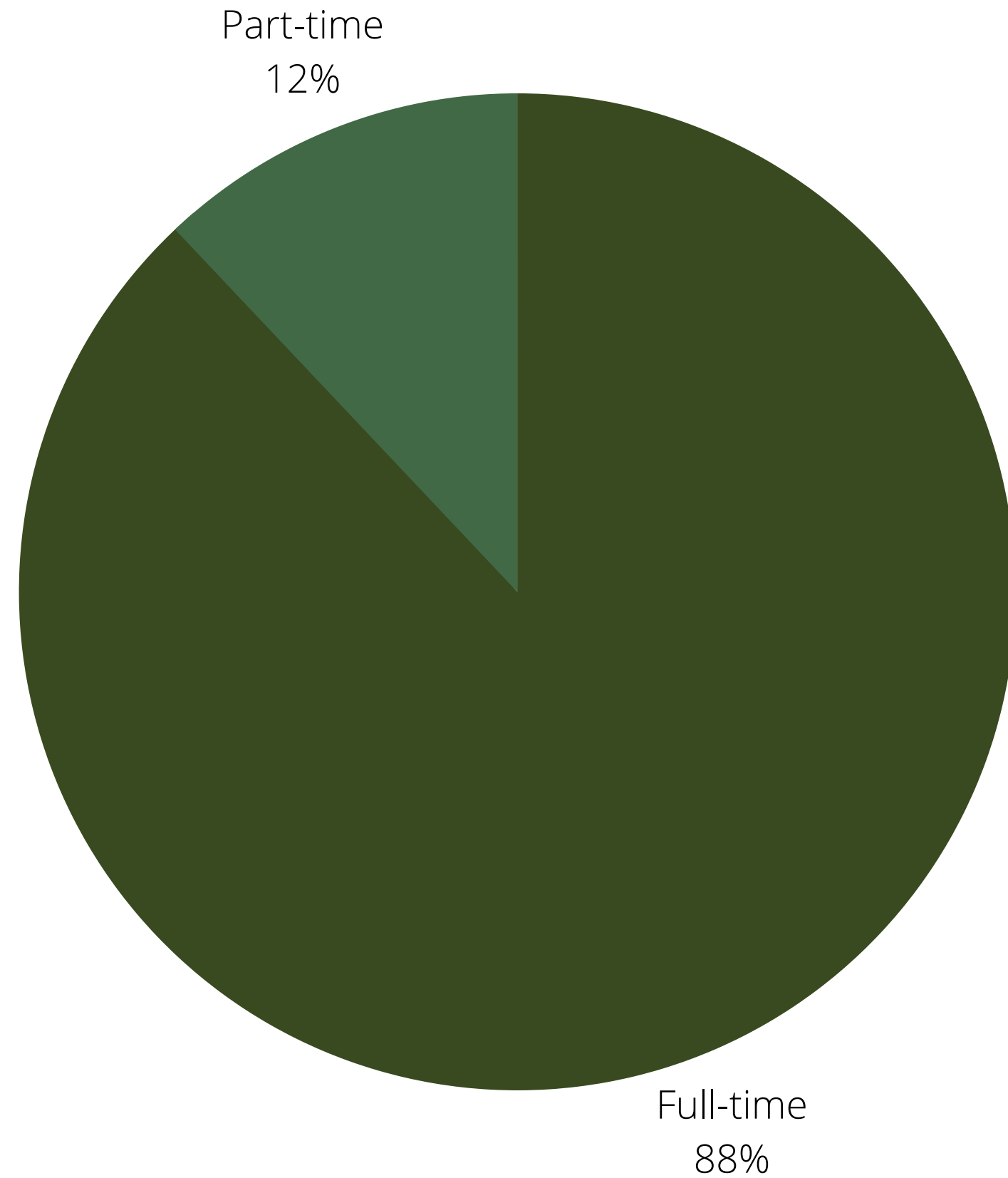




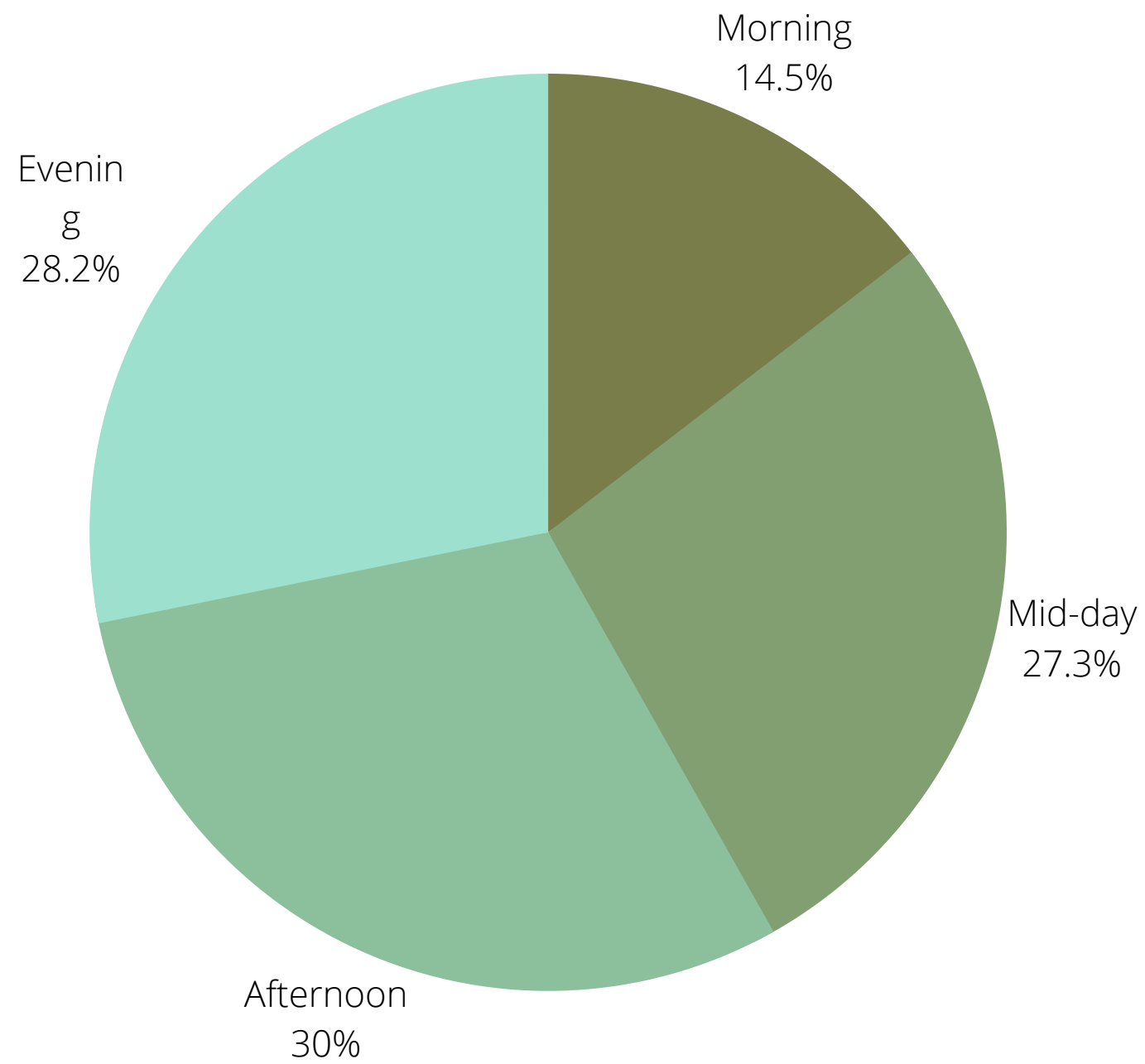
# 8. What garage renovation would be the best use of space and make the most impact on the community?



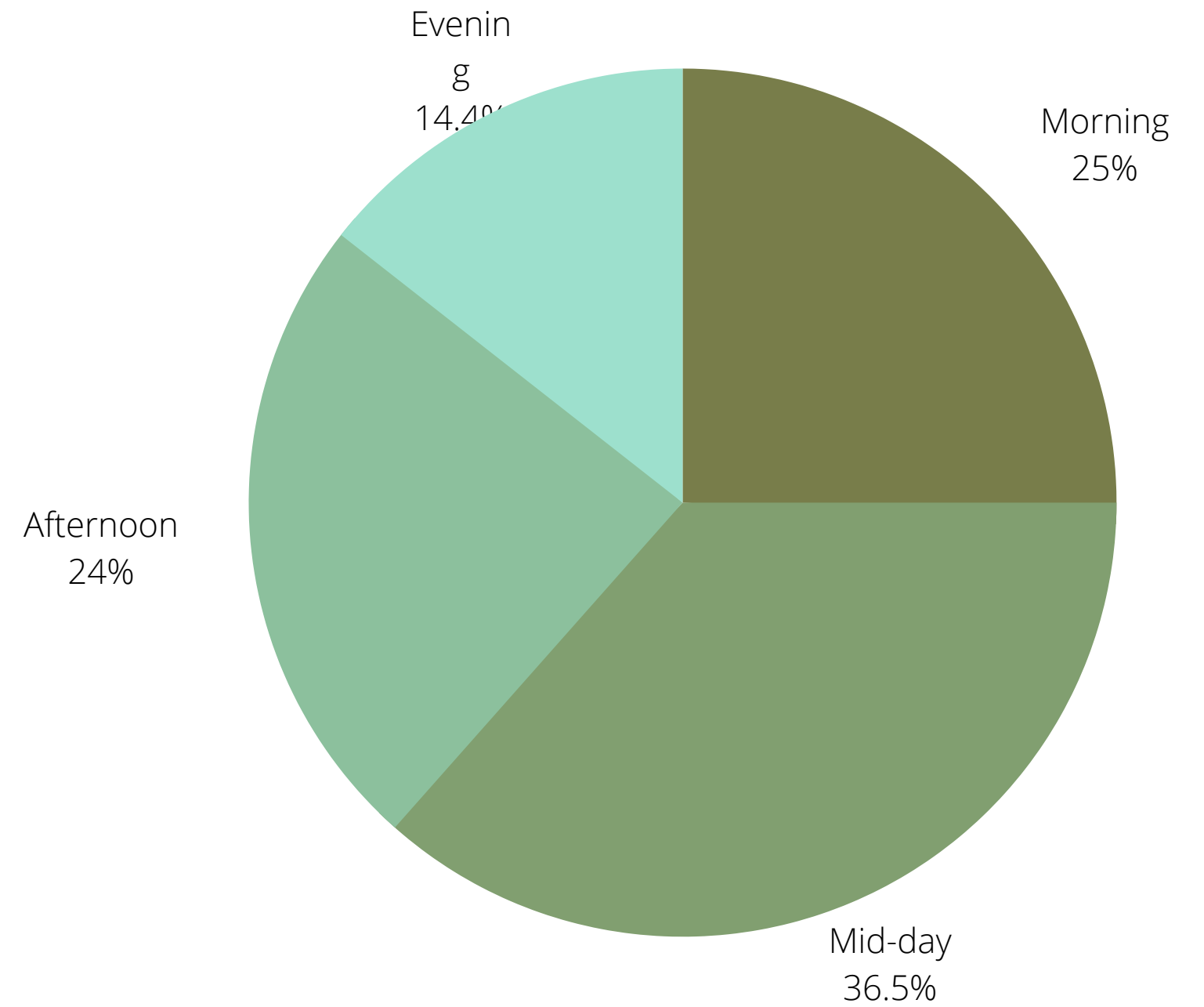

# 10. What are the most convenient times for you to use the Library and attend programs?

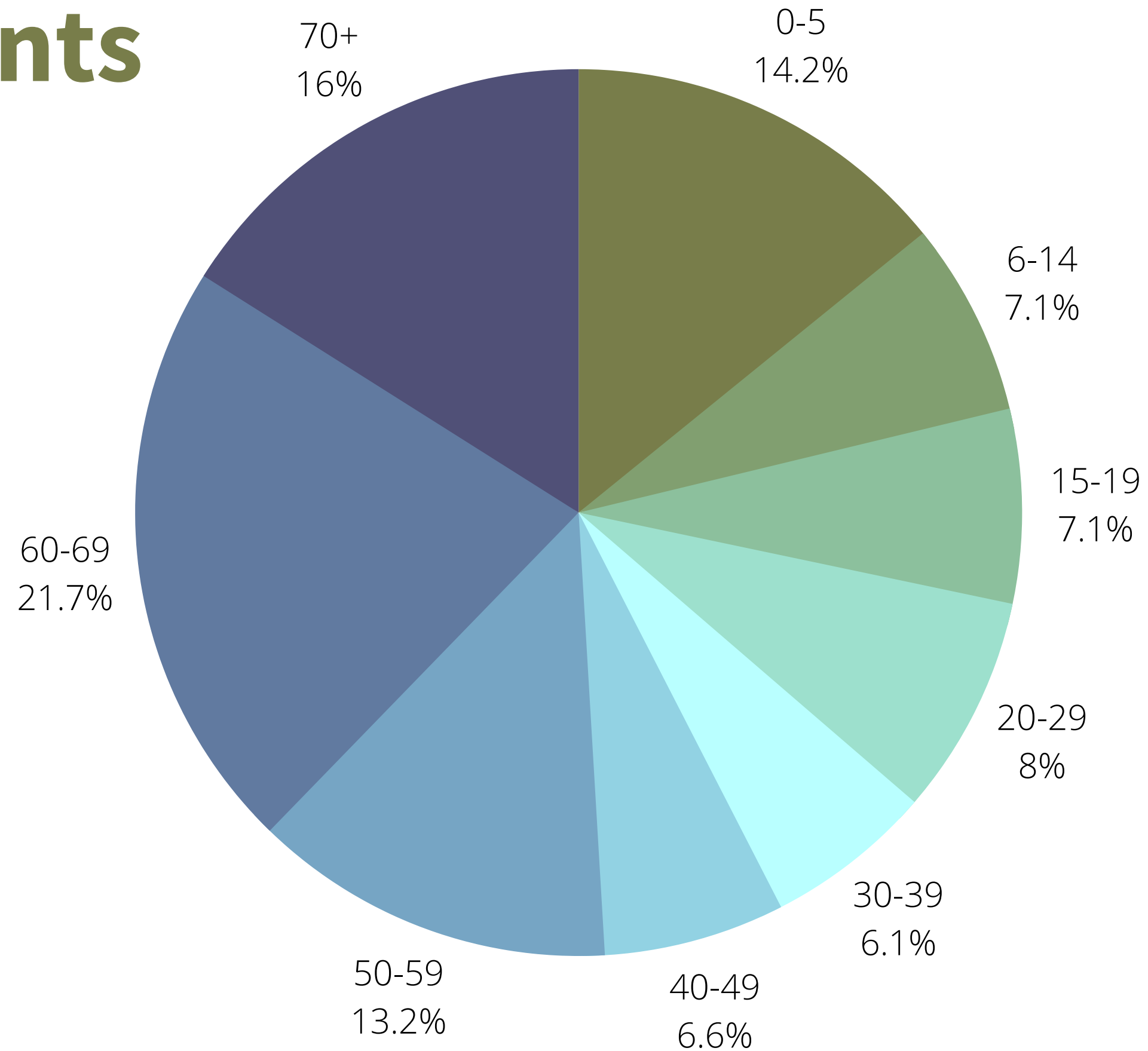
