As an educational and cultural institution, the Olive Free Library welcomes exhibits and displays of interest, information, and enlightenment to the community. Displays of artwork, handiwork, historical material, nature study, or any other material deemed of general interest may be exhibited. The Library Director shall accept or reject material offered for display based on its suitability and availability of adequate display space. The Library assumes no responsibility for the preservation or protection, and no liability for possible damage or theft of any item displayed or exhibited. All items placed in the Library are there at the owner's risk. A release must be signed by the exhibitor before any artifact can be placed in the library.

Curated exhibits in the Community Room Art Gallery are excluded from this policy and are subject to the rules of the Olive Free Library-Exhibition Policy.
