Biographical History:

Elwyn Crispell Davis was born in February 23, 1890 in West Shokan, New York to Chase West Davis and Matie Crispell.

Elwyn C. Davis married Daisy Belle Simpson December 20, 1910 in West Shokan, New York. They had three children: Mariam Crispell Davis b. July 28, 1914 in Kerhonkson, NY; Cornelia May Davis b. June 27, 1918 in West Shokan, NY; Lillian Ellen Davis b. October 22, 1927 in West Shokan, NY, d. January 2, 1932.

Scope and Content:

The Elwyn C. Davis collection primarily consists of Davis's diaries dated between 1906 and 1975 and their respective transcriptions. In his diaries Davis records aspects of the weather such as temperature, precipitation, and cloud cover, as well as his daily activities including chores, social interactions, and local events.

The Davis collection additionally contains books about local history, ledgers for local businesses, schools attendance records, and daybooks for local residents in West Shokan. The business ledgers record the names of patrons, their purchases and total expenses. The school attendance records record the pupils' names, ages, grades, and their weekly attendance. Day books record the manual labor of the book's owner on the behalf of neighbors and local residents in terms of monetary values and vice versa. Day books were used to record favors traded and owed amongst neighbors and friends.

In many cases, the news clippings found within the collection are contained within the original postmarked envelopes received by Elwyn C. Davis. The remainder of news clippings are as yet unprocessed and are loosely placed in an archival container.

Arrangement:

Series 1 containing Davis's diaries and Series 3 comprised of news clippings are arranged chronologically by the date they were created. All other materials included in the Davis collection – photographs and ephemera - are arranged according to original order – the order in which the collection's creator placed the individual items or the order in which the Olive Free Library received the items.
